If you or your business have rental property, you $\underline{\textit{MUST}}$ install carbon monoxide alarms! Also, your home $\underline{\textit{MUST}}$ have one too.

Illinois has recently passed a bill requiring all owners of residential property to install an approved carbon monoxide alarm (Public Act 094-0741). This bill requires all residences to have carbon monoxide alarms if they have attached garages.

Also, another bill allows a tenant to avoid paying rent if there is a threat of domestic or sexual violence or they are a victim of sexual violence on the premises controlled by a landlord. A landlord \underline{MUST} change the locks within 48 hours of a written request.
